The True source of the Sans "... the aqueduct, where one reads the rest of the inscription shown in fig.II and supplicated in figure III. With letters NERO according to the most probable interpretation, that many more did not want to occupy the space, or they lack it, thus composing the word NERONIONIANA, which, all that is a solecism for the increase of the two ON-I syllables. Incompatible in the centuries of Latin; but it may be derived from the inevitability of the craftsmen in its composition." GBP
